
4.) SUNDAY: A Garden for Contemplation

Symbols of liberty will overflow into every corner of **Rockefeller Gardens** as numerous military color guards and color corps enter and assume their position for this inspiring 90-minute ceremony. The guest speaker will be Captain Mark Leary, US Navy, invocation will be rendered by Rabbi Howard Schwartz, US Army Major (retired), and the benediction will be by Chaplain Willie Branch. Visitors will receive a carnation upon arrival at Rockefeller Gardens to pay tribute to veterans and will render a final

tribute as they move forward in procession, to place their flowers beside the Memorial Marker as a personal "thank you."
