




What is already being done in Middle School?

Clubs vs Student Assistants/Volunteers

Clubs

- Can determine when/where to meet with students
- More control over who is in club
- Not all schools have clubs
- Access to funds through fundraising as a club/club dues

Student Assistants/Volunteers

- If in a class, students are given grades
- Consistently see students at regular days and times
- Volunteers can be there before or after school
- Students in a class are not always the students we would choose.
