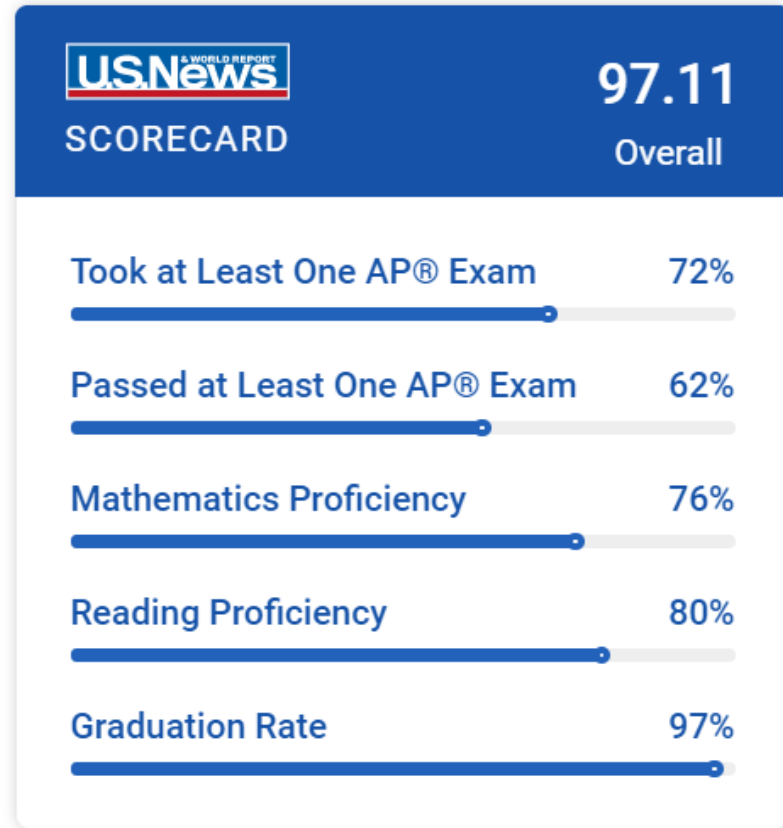

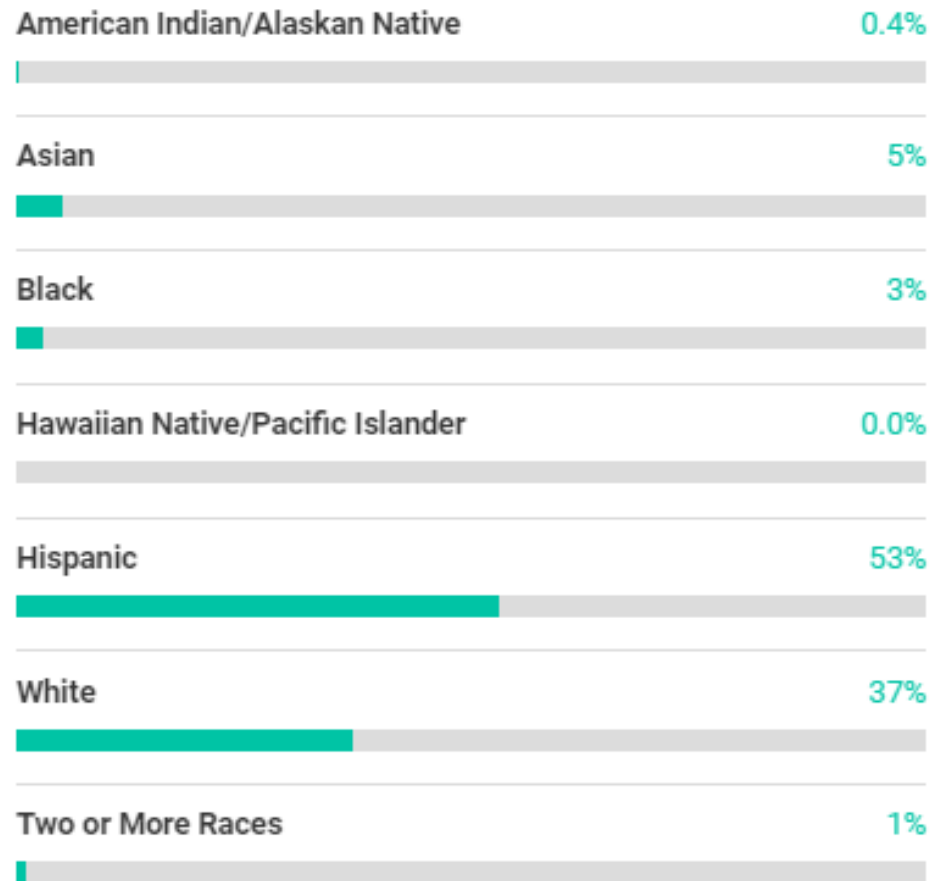

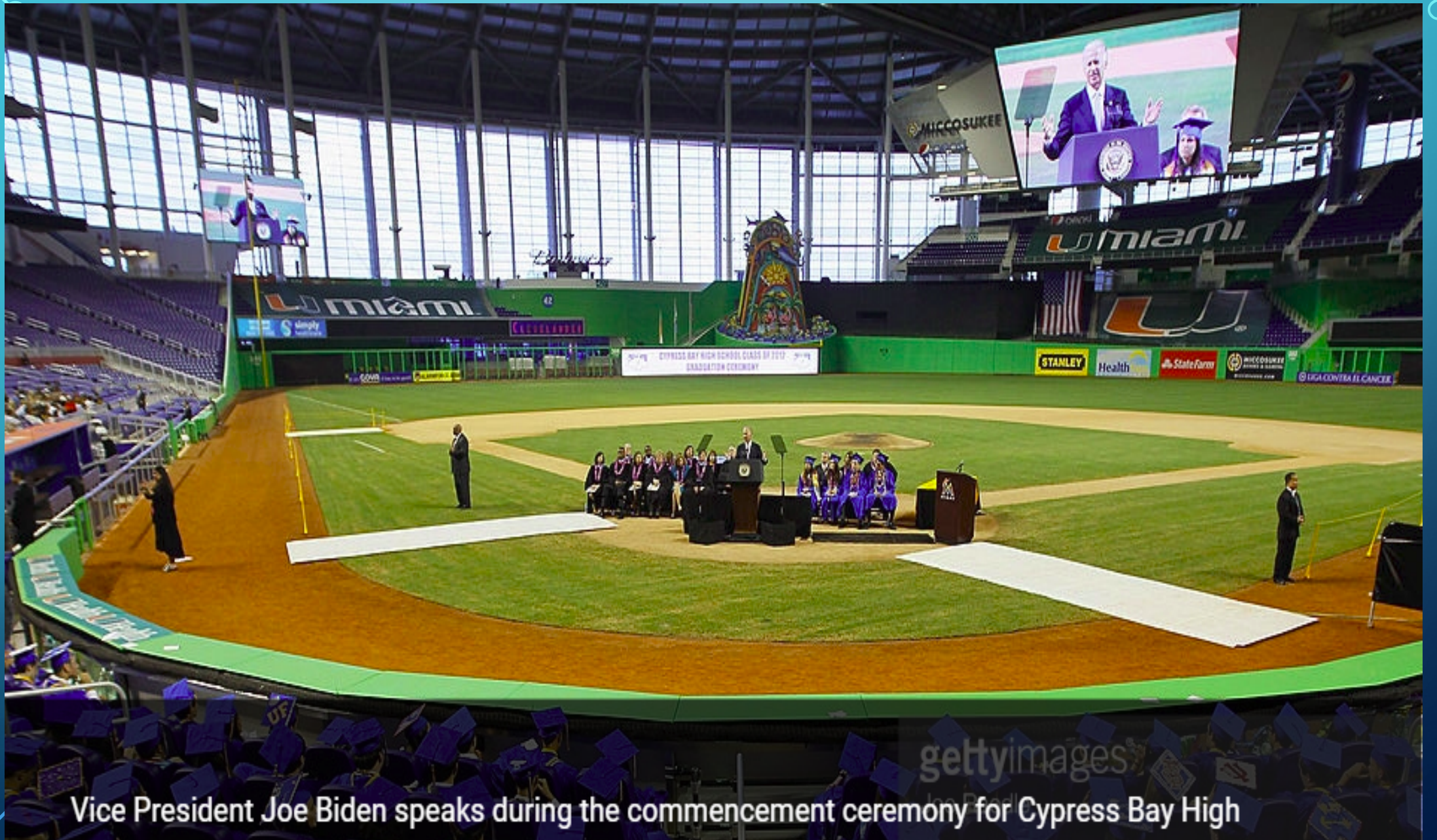
This is the breakdown of ethnicity and gender of a school's student body, based on data reported to the government.
