

## This tutorial explains how to register for a self-enroll course and become a Cisco Networking Academy student

### Part 1: Registration

Once you click the self-enroll link provided by your Academy/Instructor you arrive at the page looking similar to the example below. Fill your details, double check your email is correct and Click "Submit":




