


This tutorial explains how to register for a self-enroll course and become a Cisco Networking Academy student

Part 1: Registration




Check your email inbox, there should be a message with a subject: "Get Started with Cisco Networking Academy". Click on the "Confirm email address":



Follow the registration procedure:




After the registration is completed you will see the main post-login page. Under "I'm learning" section there is a list of courses available for you.




Next time use your e-mail address as a login and the password you've set to login at: www.netacad.com
