MOTORCOACH PARKING IN HISTORIC OLD TOWN ALEXANDRIA REQUIRES A FREE PARKING PERMIT THAT CAN BE OBTAINED THROUGH ONLINE REGISTRATION. ADDITIONAL FREE, UNRESERVED PARKING LOCATIONS ARE AVAILABLE WITHIN THREE MILES OF OLD TOWN. PAID SHORT-TERM AND LONG-TERM PARKING ARE ALSO AVAILABLE.



MOTORCOACH PARKING RULES

- \$50 fine for engine idling beyond 15 mins
- \$200 fine for double parking or obstructing traffic while loading/unloading
- \$100 fine for using an unauthorized parking space
- Buses are allowed on most streets in the City of Alexandria except cobblestone streets or those posted with "no truck traffic" signs

SHORT-TERM PARKING

Free short-term parking can be reserved by applying for a free parking permit by visiting, <http://apps.alexandriava.gov/MotorcoachReservations>.

- Waterfront/Robinson Terminal: 500 block of N Union St.
- Five spaces between Oronoco and Pendleton streets, east side, northbound; Free four-hour parking can be reserved online a first-come, first-served basis.

- North Old Town: 900 block of North St.
- Aspah Street: Three spaces, west side, southbound: Free four-hour parking can be reserved online.

UNRESERVED PARKING

Free parking spaces are available within 3 miles of historic Old Town:

- Swann Avenue: 400 Block Swann Ave. Up to seven spaces, south side. Spaces are available March through June only from 4 - 11 p.m. Monday through Friday and 8 a.m. - 11 p.m. on weekends/holidays.

LONG-TERM/OVERNIGHT PARKING

Reserved long-term/overnight parking for \$35 per 24 hours is available; short-term parking for up to four hours (\$10):

- George Washington Masonic Memorial: 101 Callahan Dr., 25 spaces. Parking permits must be obtained in advance from the City of Alexandria.



MOTORCOACH LOADING & UNLOADING

The Alexandria Police Department will strictly enforce any violations, so be sure to load and unload only in designated areas throughout the historic district, including:

- **The Waterfront and Torpedo Factory Art Center:** Unit block of King Street (one space), north side, westbound, behind King Street Trolley. Do not load/unload on Union or Cameron streets.
- **The Strand:** 100 block. No sidewalk. Do not block the Old Dominion Boat Club Parking Entrance. 200 block. No sidewalk.
- **Market Square, Historic District Restaurants, Visitors Center, or Walking Tours:** 300 block of King Street (five spaces), north side, west-bound between Fairfax and Royal streets.
- **Gadsby's Tavern Museum and Gadsby's Tavern Restaurant:** 100 block of North Royal Street (one space), west side, southbound between Cameron & King streets, directly in front of Gadsby's Tavern Museum & Restaurant.
- **Christ Church, Shopping & Dining or King Street Trolley:** 100 block of N. Washington Street (five spaces), between Cameron & King streets, west side, southbound except 4 - 6 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- **The Lyceum:** 200 block of S Washington Street (one space), west side, southbound except 4 - 6 p.m. Monday through Friday
