- Dunbar was the first African-American to gain acceptance in literary circles in the United States.
- A National Historic Landmark, the house is virtually unchanged from the time of the writer's death in 1906.
- Artifacts in the house include a bicycle given to Dunbar by the Wrights, books, furniture and clothing.
