New Attractions, Accommodations and More on the 'Original American Beach'

DAYTONA BEACH, Fla. – Visitors are discovering a new <u>Daytona Beach</u> – an exciting chapter in the destination's history showcasing its racing heritage, idyllic East Coast oceanfront location and impressive arts affiliation. The area is investing nearly \$2 billion in renovations and construction, all of which make for an even more exciting vacation stay. The \$400 million renovation project at <u>Daytona International Speedway</u> was completed in January 2016. In the planning stage are an exclusive Marriott Autograph Collection® hotel called The DAYTONA and an upscale Westin. These additions – and an eclectic culinary scene, off-the-beaten-path attractions for thrill seekers and year-round cultural events – offer visitors unexpected delights on their Florida beach vacation and have led 2016 TripAdvisor to select <u>Daytona Beach</u> as one of the "10 Most Affordable Beach Vacations on Florida's East Coast." Daytona Beach was named one of the "Best Florida Attractions" in the Top 10 Best Readers' Choice travel award contest sponsored by *USA TODAY*.

Accommodations Galore





The area is home to the Residence Inn by Marriott Daytona Beach Oceanfront (opened March 2015), the Hilton Garden Inn boutique (opened September 2015), and the Chateau Mar Beach Resort boutique property (opened October 2015). Westin is totally re-styling and transforming one of the area's iconic beachfront properties and is scheduled to open in 2017. The historic Streamline Hotel, an art deco-style property that once hosted the meeting that launched NASCAR – as well as an episode of Hotel Impossible – will be opening as an upscale beachside boutique property in 2017. The Acapulco Inn is being transformed into the Delta by Marriott Daytona Beach, and expected to open in May 2017. Visitors will also enjoy two planned hotels at ONE DAYTONA, a premier mixed use retail, dining and entertainment complex being built across from the Daytona International Speedway, offering a total of 250 rooms. The Fairfield Inn & Suites is opening in summer 2017, followed by an exclusive Marriott Autograph Collection® hotel called The DAYTONA, planned for early 2018. On the horizon - at least five new properties are expected to open in the Daytona Beach are by 2019.

Non-Stop Flights from New York City, Atlanta and Charlotte



JetBlue Airways launched a new route to Daytona Beach International Airport (DAB) in January 2016. The airline offers daily, non-stop service from John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK,) providing the Daytona Beach area with direct flights to New York City. In addition to JFK, visitors to Daytona Beach also have non-stop service from Atlanta (Delta)

and Charlotte, NC (American Airlines) – with hundreds of connecting flights.



National Retailers to Anchor 'One Daytona' Development



ONE DAYTONA is a premier mixed-use retail, dining and entertainment destination across from Daytona International Speedway and minutes from the "World's Most Famous Beach". Cobb Daytona Luxury Theatres, one of the destination's anchor tenants, opened to rave reviews in December 2016 and will be followed close behind by Bass Pro Shops in early 2017. Visitors will enjoy two planned hotels totaling 250 rooms with the Fairfield Inn & Suites opening in summer 2017, followed by an exclusive Marriott Autograph Collection® hotel called The DAYTONA, planned for early 2018.

When the destination celebrates its grand opening in late 2017, several retail, dining and entertainment tenants, along with Victory Circle, the center's epicenter of excitement, will open including P.F. Chang's, Hy's Toggery, Kilwins Confections, Guitar Center, Tervis, IT'SUGAR, Jeremiah's Italian Ice, Oklahoma Joe's BBQ, Rock Bottom Restaurant & Brewery, MidiCi: The Neapolitan Pizza Company, Venetian Nail Spa, Sunglass World, and GameTime among others. The development boasts approximately 300,000 square feet and will quickly become a place where visitors, race fans and residents can live, work, stay and play.

The Daytona Beach area's <u>culinary scene</u> is experiencing a steady influx of exciting, new offerings – from off-the-beaten-path eateries to independent restaurants serving specialty fare. Now 25 years strong and with a guest list of 125,000 it is the area's largest fall festival. Popular venues include Main Street, Destination Daytona, Beach Street, Midtown, New Smyrna Beach and DeLand. This extended weekend of fun and sun includes motorcycle shows and rallies, live music, scenic rides along A1A and other historic roadways, racing at Daytona International and New Smyrna Speedways and vendors offering everything from the latest models to parts and accessories.

Arts & Culture



The **Cici and Hyatt Brown Museum of Art**, a 26,000 square foot museum, opened in 2015 on the campus of the Smithsonian-affiliated **Museum of Arts and Sciences**. It is home to an extensive collection of more than 2,700 Florida oil and watercolor paintings. The mezzanine features a permanent gallery showcasing the collection's signature pieces. The Museum also includes six smaller, changing galleries, conference and education rooms, a café with outdoor seating and a gift shop. 'World Center of Racing' Reimagines an American Icon



Race fans are rejoicing over the <u>DAYTONA Rising</u> Project – a \$400 million overhaul that transformed **Daytona International Speedway** into the world's first true motorsports stadium. This world-class facility with premium amenities and unparalleled conveniences opened to fans in 2016. By the numbers – three new concourse levels now span the frontstretch; five expanded and redesigned fan entrances called 'injectors'; 11 social areas dubbed 'neighborhoods,' each the size of a football field with open sightlines and dozens of video screens to capture the ontrack action; more than 60 new luxury trackside suites with patios; 17 elevators and

40 escalators in the new grandstand; and, 101,500 new 20"-21" grandstand seats featuring backs and arm rests. In addition, more than 7,000 solar panels will make the sports complex one of the top five largest solar installations at a professional sports venue in the country.
