AIRPORT UPDATE

Total passenger traffic for the month of February was 1,998,069, up .9% over February 2013. JetBlue Airways will launch a new route to Pittsburgh International Airport (PIT) on October 29, 2014. JetBlue currently operates 26 nonstop routes out of FLL, with five more new routes already announced to begin in 2014/15. On May 1, JetBlue will add three new nonstop routes from FLL to Montego Bay (Jamaica), Port of Spain (Trinidad and Tobago) and Punta Cana (Dominican Republic). Next year, the airline also intends to launch a nonstop route to Albany, NY.
