MILESTONES AND MEMORIES: MONTEREY COUNTY CELEBRATES A YEAR OF NOTABLE ANNIVERSARIES IN 2017

MONTEREY, Calif., December XXX, 2016 – One does not have to think hard when coming up with reasons to celebrate in beautiful Monterey County. The breath-taking sights alone are worth bringing out the party hats. With the picturesque location and a plethora of activities and attractions, visitors travel from all over the world to commemorate anniversaries and life's major milestones in the destination.

As we look back at 2016, Monterey County had a glittering year of anniversaries including Carmel-by-the-Sea's centennial celebration which was capped off with a parade grand marshalled by none other than the former Mayor, Clint Eastwood. The Monterey Regional Airport celebrated its 75th anniversary in 2016 and Bubba Gump Shrimp Co. toasted to 20 years on Cannery Row.

With a New Year right around the corner, Monterey County is gearing up for another milestone year filled with festivities and celebrations honoring the past but with an eye to the future. Here is a list of some most notable anniversaries coming up in 2017:

- It was 50 years ago this June that folks from all over gathered in Monterey for the first ever commercial American rock festival, the **Monterey Pop Festival**. Now in 2017, Monterey is expecting to bring that energy back to the peninsula by celebrating the **50**th **Anniversary of the Summer of Love** with several special events, including musical performances and art exhibits. Organizers are planning the main celebration for the weekend of June 16-18th, exactly 50 years to the day of the original Monterey Pop to be held at the original venue, the Monterey County Fairgrounds. seemonterey.com/events/music-festivals/summer-of-love
- In September, the **Monterey Jazz Festival** will be celebrating its 60th anniversary and continues to be the longest running jazz festival in the world. The event is held annually at the Monterey County Fairgrounds, which has been the site of the festival since the beginning. Attendees can expect to see more than 500 top jazz artists perform throughout the weekend of September 15-17th and on eight different stages spread throughout the fairgrounds. montereyjazzfestival.org
- 2017 is proving to be quite the celebration of music in Monterey County. The Carmel Bach Festival celebrates its 80th anniversary! From July 15-29th, maestro Paul Goodwin has assembled some incredibly exciting programs including featuring Bach's Ascension Oratorio and selections from Handel's Messiah on opening night as well as a grand finale of Beethoven's 9th Symphony, "Ode to Joy," his expression of universal brotherhood and ecstatic joy. bachfestival.org
- Cheers to the 10th anniversary of the Pebble Beach Food & Wine, a gourmet event with more than 250 acclaimed wineries paired with 100 celebrity chefs. From April 20-23rd, attendees will have the opportunity to

taste award-winning wines and enjoy culinary innovations with one of the world's most recognized coastlines as the backdrop. pbfw.com

- The oceanfront retreat, Hyatt Carmel Highlands, will be celebrating 100 years of sophisticated hospitality with
 the completion of one of the most exciting renovations in its history. The property opened 21 years before

- This April, the **Monterey Conference Center** is celebrating its 40th anniversary and will be opening its doors in the early spring after undergoing more than \$60+ million in renovations. The Conference Center reflects the City of Monterey's continued tradition of hospitality while providing visitors an upscale facility for both meetings and activities within walking distance of Fisherman's Wharf and several restaurants, beachside activities and sights. - In charming Carmel-by-the-Sea, the **Hofsas House**, a boutique family-owned and operated hotel, is celebrating 70 years of European hospitality. The Bavarian-inspired property is commemorating this special birthday with several new hotel packages as well as a leisurely, fun and informative two-hour history tour around the one-square mile city. Discover secret pathways and hidden courtyards, and when you are finished, you will feel like you have been a Carmel local for decades. - Dali17, the first permanent Salvador Dali exhibition on the West Coast and the largest private collection of the Spanish surrealist work in the country, will be celebrating its first anniversary in July of 2017. The exhibition includes more than 570 pieces such as original etchings, mixed media, rare sculptures and lithographs. Dali was an original in the Carmel Art Association and a regular in Monterey County during WWII. dali17.com
